• **1930 Model A Ford Two Door Hardtop.** Four new tires (on the ground) with new inner tubes. New battery rack. Custom built new floorboards with weatherproofing both top and bottom. New front floor mat. Rebuilt carburetor with new modern machined parts. New downdraft air filter (prevents backfiring). New fan belt. No fluid leaks. Runs well and purrs like a kitten. Has been stored in a heated garage. The current owner just doesn't have the time to work on it due to other projects. Wants to pass it along to another enthusiast who can do right by it. It would take very little to make this parade worthy. Clear title.

• **1925, Standard Six, Model 28 (2 Door Coupe)** - 98% original and in good running order. There were two engine options for 1925, the Standard Six and the Master Six. The Standard Six was a six-cylinder 191 cu in (3.1L) In Line, or Straight Six. The Master Six was the higher end and more powerful model in the Buick lineup at 255 cu in (4.2L). Both were dual overhead valve (a huge innovation for the day). The In Line six was more expensive to build, but many believe it has proven over the years to be a better and longer lasting workhorse than the more modern V6. This model is listed on the Title as a Master Six engine, but the Wheelbase measures 114.5 inches which conforms to the Standard Six specifications. The coolant system has one line that leads to the top of the head. This is for the Standard Six. The Master Six had one line that branched off into three "feet" that supplied water for the front, middle, and rear of the head. The Standard Six was much more reliable as the Master Six had a number of problems getting it's longer block cooled. In future models Buick changed the water feed system to have four "feet" with tapering lines to better distribute the coolant. A little homework would probably solve the mystery as there are records on engine production numbers (they did them in blocks that were intermixed, so you will need the actual Buick Motor Division Car and Engine Data). This engine number is 1283728. In the 1920's, Buick did not match the numbers on the frames to the numbers on the engines. The frame number for this car does match the registry for Standard Six models for 1925. Master Six started with 121 for that year. The Standard Six for 1925 started with 123 and went through 127. This vehicle's frame number is 1264718. The plate on the firewall says 25-25, which is the 1925 4 Door Touring (convertible with no windows in the doors). It was very common in the past that you had to have the plate to be able to register the car. If the plate was lost, a replacement plate may have been gotten from a scrap yard. This was also very common as during the metal drives for WWII these cars were often scrapped, and spare parts were abundant. It appears that the engine, body, and frame of this vehicle are all original and correct. It is rare to be all together as most cars from that time frame are a mix of whatever parts from different model years were lying around. This car has a three speed on the floor manual transmission and has very little rust with extremely solid panels, fenders, hood, etc. Front and rear bumpers were not standard but could be added for an additional cost. It appears that was the case at some point, either at original purchase or sometime after. The seating configuration is for a driver and two passengers in the back and a fold out seat (for easy storage when not in use) in the front passenger position. This would conform to the Four Passenger Two Door Coupe. The space behind the driver is intentionally not seating and was for the amenities that came with buying what Buick intended to be a higher-level vehicle compared to the competition in 1925. All in all, it is very rare to find this model in original factory configuration, let alone in this condition. A bit of TLC and this could easily be a Show Queen. The current owner has had it garage kept in a heated garage and just doesn't have the time to work on it and wants to pass it on to someone who will be able to bring back its original shine. 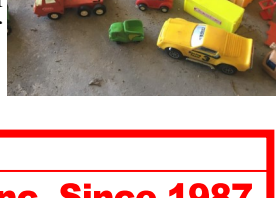
